Unaffiliated Dressage Shows - 2009

Entries close on the Monday prior to the show and will be taken on a first come, first served basis. Late entries may be accepted after this date subject to a late entry fee of £2, (please phone Lucy Thompson). Withdrawals accepted until the Thursday prior to the competition. Any withdrawals made after this are refundable if replaced. Entries cannot be transferred. Send or drop off to Pennine View Stud, Beckwith Head Road, Harrogate, HG3 1RB. Please do not drop entries off at or send to YRC. Cheques to be made payable to Pennine View Stud.

Open to horse/rider combinations that have no more than 49BD or 25 BE points for Prelim classes and 124 BD or 50 BE points in Novice classes. All unaffiliated classes are run under British Dressage rules. Dressage tests used will be the current versions in use by British Dressage. The entry fee is £10 to make it financially viable to run the shows. Points will be awarded for each of the 4 summer shows on a horse and rider combination basis. At the end of the summer the results of the points tally will be awarded cash prizes and rosettes. See www.pennineviewstud.co.uk for more details

The classes may be split into sections if needed to make the class smaller and the wait time between classes shorter. Hence class 1 A will start at approx 9am, class 2 A will start at approx 11 am class 1 B will start at approx 12.30am and class 2 B at approx 2pm and class 3 and 4 to follow. Please state on entry forms if you have any preference for times. If you or if you know anyone who would like to sponsor a class please contact Lucy Thompson. Times available between 3pm & 7pm on the Friday before the show on 07715 115164, or on the www.PennineViewStud.co.uk website. Classes start at approx 9am & will finish by 6pm approx.

Unaffiliated One Day Events – 2009

Entries close on the Monday before and will be taken on a first come first served basis. Late entries may be taken after this date subject to a late entry fee of £2 (please phone Lucy Thompson 07715 115164) on show days to find out times for classes.

Withdrawals accepted until the Thursday prior to the competition. Any withdrawals made after this are refundable if replaced. Entries cannot be transferred. Send or drop off to Pennine View Stud, Beckwith Head Road, Harrogate, HG3 1RB. Please do not drop entries off at or send to YRC. Cheques to be made payable to Pennine View Stud. Open to horse/rider combinations that have not competed affiliated BE or Open PC teams. Will be run under British Eventing (BE) rules except that the dressage test can be read, you can carry sticks, and you can use the bit/tack you need for jumping to speed things up but no boots.

Conditions Applying to all Events/Shows:

1. No responsibility will be accepted by the organisers (Pennine View Stud) or the Yorkshire Riding Centre for anything that may happen to competitors, their horses, property or helpers in connection with or arising from this show. It will be considered a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to indemnify Pennine View Stud and the Yorkshire Riding Centre against any legal action arising there from.
2. The decision of the judges is final. Any objection should be made to the organiser (Pennine View Stud) together with a deposit of £25 to be forfeited if the objection is not upheld
3. The organiser (Pennine View Stud) reserves the right to refuse any entry or amend the schedule if the instances of the programme require
4. Hard hats must be worn at all times when mounted. Rider's protective helmet must be manufactured to the latest British Standard or such other suitable headgear as offers a similar or higher level of protection and is at least that of British Standard EN1384. Riders with unsuitable headgear may be refused entry. Riders must be correctly dressed including those working in. For affiliated competitions please refer to the relevant organisation rules.
5. No entry will be accepted without the correct entry fee. Cheques to be made payable to Pennine View Stud.
6. Dressage entries will be limited and will be taken on a first come, first served basis. Entry fees for withdrawals will not be refunded unless the resulting space can be filled and only 50% of the fee will be returned if the withdrawal is made no less than 48 hrs prior to the competition.

Prizes and rosettes are as stated in the schedule but in the event of insufficient starters, they will be given in the ratio of one prize per five starters. The unaffiliated shows will be run under the guidelines of the BSJA or British Dressage rules as appropriate.

Health and Safety.

The organiser (Pennine View Stud) & the Yorkshire Riding Centre have taken responsible & reasonable precautions to ensure the health & safety of everyone present. For those measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid & prevent accidents occurring & must obey the instructions of the organiser Pennine View Stud, YRC staff & all officials & stewards.
